## Direct GHG emissions from AFOLU

Distribution of GHG emissions by economic sector

GHG emissions from the AFOLU sector account for **24 percent** of the total emissions (IPCC, 2014a). The AFOLU sector is the **largest emitting sector after the energy** sector.



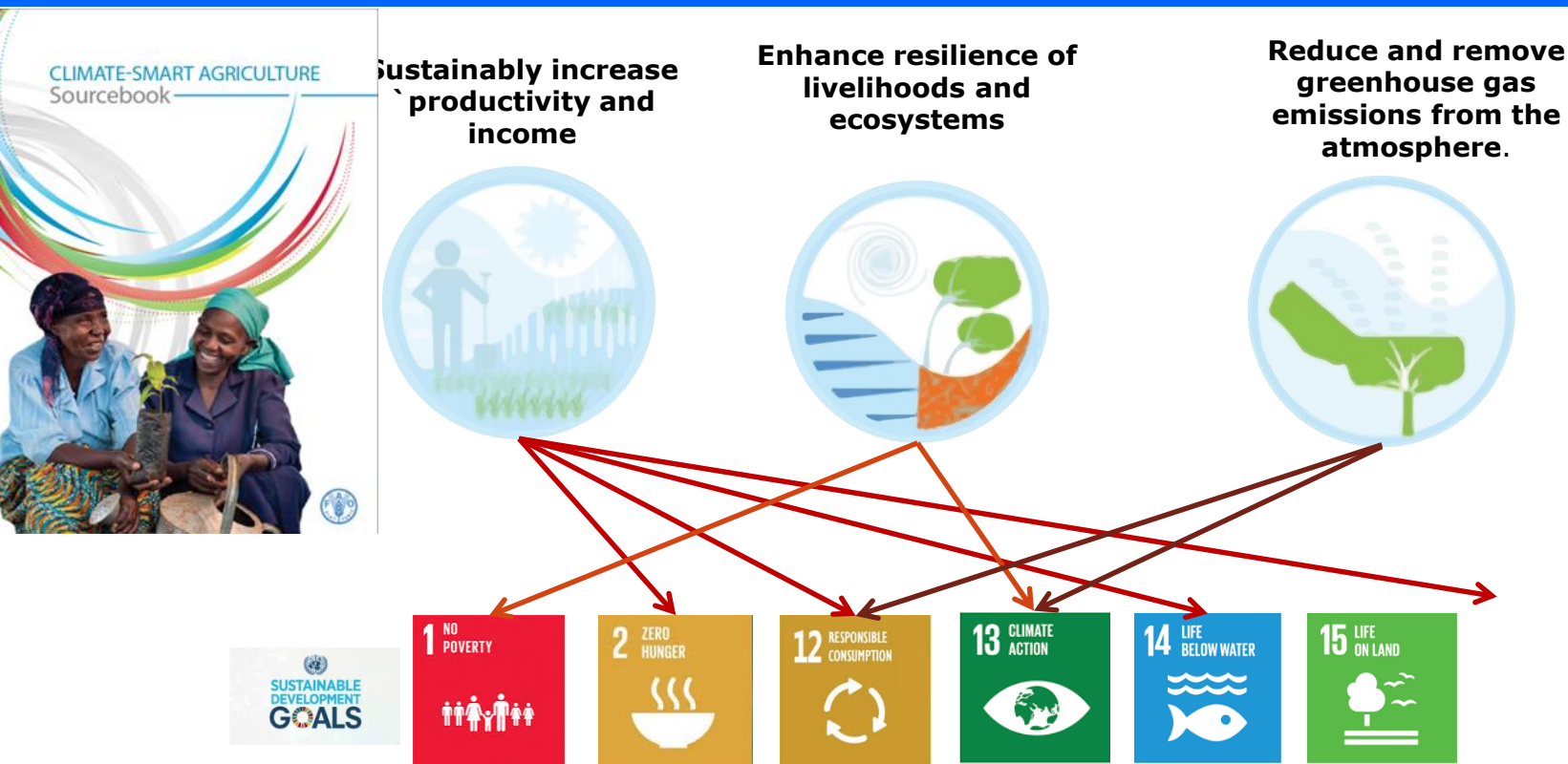
## FOCUS of FAO work on climate change

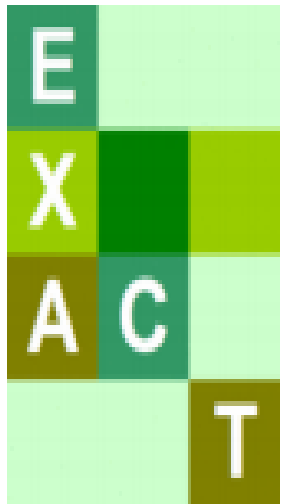
