Africa NDC in context – NDC development

- **All 54 African countries have signed the Paris Agreement**
 - More than 45 countries have already ratified the PA.
 - Despite limited guidance on structure and time for development, more than 40 countries have submitted their NDCs to the UNFCCC
- **Key Observations from NDCs reviewed.....**
 - Weak strategic alignment with national development plans and wider sustainable development goals
 - Less opportunities for maximizing co-benefits
 - Limited description of monitoring, review and reporting processes of climate actions



Africa NDC in context – NDC implementation

□ Governance structures and processes

- African countries recognize climate change is a development challenge
- Development of national climate change strategies and action plans, even at sub-national and regional levels
- Establishment of institutional frameworks

□ However.....

- Need for continuous strengthening of these frameworks
 - Appropriate delegation of authority for coordination and cooperation
 - Robust systems and processes for MRV for emissions, M&E for adaptation systems and climate finance
 - Information sharing to promote accountability and transparency
- Need for improvements in associated policies and legislation



Africa NDC in context – NDC implementation

▣ **Financing and Resource Mobilization**

- African countries making progress on accessing climate finance
- But accessed funds not commensurate to the needs
- Increasing trend in awareness of int'l climate funds
- Resources for climate action in national budgets
- Establishment of national climate change funds

▣ **However.....**

- Need to develop robust financial and investment plans
- Need for reliable data sources and comprehensive sector analyses
- Improve on the role of the private sector in NDC implementation



The Africa NDC Hub

- A collaborative platform established to support African countries in their achievements of their NDC targets by 2030.

- 15 international partners working together
- Secretariat at AfDB
- 2018-2020 Work Plan endorsed




